

## **Grant Application**

Grants are available for up to \$750 per year. Awards are at the discretion of the Autism Society of Ohio as budget allows.

The purpose of a grant is to establish or promote autism awareness and programming in Ohio counties not yet served by a local Autism Society affiliate (Adams, Allen, Ashland, Athens, Auglaize, Belmont, Brown, Carroll, Clark, Clinton, Coshocton, Crawford, Erie, Fayette, Gallia, Guernsey, Hardin, Harrison, Highland, Hocking, Holmes, Huron, Jackson, Jefferson, Lawrence, Mercer, Meigs, Monroe, Morgan, Muskingum, Noble, Perry, Pike, Richland, Ross, Scioto, Tuscarawas, Van Wert, Vinton, Washington, Wyandot). Examples of appropriate grant programs would include: the establishment of an ongoing support group; an autism friendly event; an autism awareness campaign or event; etc. Grants must be for the benefit of the community at large, rather than for single individuals.
